In 2011 the Philippi Trust have established a Counselling Network in Somerset West, in a collaboration with the Ruach Counselling centre. This network is for Lay Counsellors and Pastoral Therapists in the Helderberg area and has subsequently become a real gem for training and up skilling counsellors and therapists.

The aim of the network is to serve as a forum where lay counsellors and pastoral therapists can receive ongoing training in specialized topics related to counselling. It's also to promote each other's work, offer support and share intellectual resources with one another.

Monthly meetings are held in the Somerset West basin with regular visits by Psychiatrists, Psychologists, Social Workers and professionals who could contribute to up skilling counsellors. The meetings are open to interested lay counsellors with a willingness to learn and share their information.
